NEW FEAST DAY FOR OUR LADY OF WALSHINGHAM

The Vatican has recently granted permission for Our Lady of Walsingham to be celebrated as a new Feast in the dioceses of England, starting this year on **Tuesday 24 September**. To mark the Feast Day, The Legion of Mary will pray the rosary in front of a statue of Our Lady of Walsingham starting at 9:30am, before Holy Mass. There will also be refreshments in the clubroom after Mass. Please join us to celebrate the re-awakening of devotion to Our Lady of Walsingham.
