**World Meeting of Families:** The tenth World Meeting of Families will take place from 22<sup>nd</sup> - 26<sup>th</sup> June. Although physically hosted by the Diocese of Rome, the event will be multi-centred and spread out throughout the world's Catholic dioceses. The theme for this year is Family Love: a vocation and a path to holiness. You will be able to listen to and follow the meeting with the Holy Father by means of live streaming.

There will be an international Theological Pastoral Congress at the start and it will end with a vigil and 'Festival of Families' and a final Eucharistic celebration presided over by Pope Francis. On 26<sup>th</sup> June Pope Francis will recite the Angelus and give a mandate to all Families (11.45-12.30) Bishop David will celebrate a Thanksgiving Service for Families in the Cathedral on Sunday 26 June at 2.00pm. Everyone is very warmly invited to come, and the service will also be live-streamed.

**Sunday 26 June - Family Celebration at St Teresa's:** Here at St Teresa's, we have our own Family Celebration on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> June when we welcome our 8 children who made their First Holy Communion on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> June and their families. The children will receive their First Holy Communion Certificate and a little gift from the parish. It will be a wonderful opportunity to congratulate them and their parents and families. I hope all families will come to that Mass to honour and give thanks for their own family and to pray for God's blessings on their life together. Afterwards there will be tea, coffee and biscuits in the clubroom. Please do try to wait after mass and to join together as a Parish Family. It will be a lovely way to build up relationships, to talk and share together.
