COMMUNITY CENTRE BUILDING WORK – PARKING ARRANGEMENTS

Starting on Monday, July 27, and ending on Monday, August 31st the following arrangements will apply

- The car park will be closed to all vehicles except contractor's traffic and to all pedestrians until 5.30 on weekdays
- Mass will continue in the mornings during the week with pedestrian access only via the path between the church and the presbytery. Kingswell are aware of Mass times and will ensure your safety.
- Special arrangements will be made for funerals
- The car park will be open after 5.00pm on weekdays and at weekends.

If you need access to the car park for health reasons to attend Mass during the week, please get in touch with the parish office. The builders' compound will take up most of the space in front of the presbytery garden, so please park very carefully in the rest of the car park at weekend masses so that as many people as possible who want to park can do so. We will keep you up to date with any changes to these arrangements. Please keep watch for them. Arrangements for September will be announced in late August.
