COMMUNITY CENTRE UPDATE & PARKING

ARRANGEMENTS

Kingswell, our builders, will be here next Thursday and Friday to prepare so that work can start on Monday, July 27th. They will be marking out the garden, creating a construction zone, arranging temporary water and power supplies and putting up safety notices, etc. Your safety will be paramount during the period that they are working on site. The biggest safety risk is during the period they are doing the groundworks and erecting the frame of the new building, which will last until the end of August, when diggers, heavy dumper trucks, concrete mixers and a crane will be using the car park, and materials are being delivered. These are very large vehicles which will need the freedom of the car park to manoeuvre. It became very clear in discussions with Kingswell that we have to close the car park until 5.30pm during weekdays in August to all traffic except the builders for safety reasons.

Starting on Monday, July 27, and ending on Monday, August 31st the following arrangements will apply

- The car park will be closed to all vehicles except contractor's traffic and to all pedestrians until 5.30 on weekdays
- Mass will continue at 10.00 am during the week with pedestrian access only via the path between the church and the presbytery. Kingswell are aware of Mass times and will ensure your safety.
- Special arrangements will be made for funerals
- It will not be possible to hold Coffee & Co on Tuesdays.
- The car park will be open after 5.00pm on weekdays and at weekends.

If you need access to the car park for health reasons to attend Mass during the week, please get in touch with the parish office. The builders' compound will take up most of the space in front of the presbytery garden, so please park very carefully in the rest of the car park at weekend masses so that as many people as possible who want to park can do so.

We will keep you up to date with any changes to these arrangements. Please keep watch for them. Arrangements for September will be announced in late August.

Please note that the Funeral Service for Gertrud Clara Goss will take place here at St Teresa's on Friday 24th July at 2.00pm – There will also be morning Mass at 10.00am as usual on this day
