Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking: Bishop David has highlighted the alarming number of modern slavery victims in the UK and the significant number of people in parishes in our Diocese who are being held in squalor and undertaking forced labour.

He has asked all of us in the first instance to become more informed about this dreadful evil by consulting the information and resource area which Caritas Northampton has created on the diocesan website. Caritas Northampton will also be developing strategies to help detect modern slavery in our communities and help provide victim support and care.
